## Pastoral Pondering . . . . .

<sup>24</sup>This is the day that the LORD has made;  
let us rejoice and be glad in it.

We all have much for which to be thankful, and one of the many things for which I'm thankful is the opportunity to serve with you in the Kingdom of God. God has brought us together, and I'm enjoying the journey of faith we share together. Now, as we come to the month of August, I'd like to share some thoughts with you about the fall and beyond.

### Greeters:

I'm am told by the youth that they "don't know who that person is." So, I'd like to ask all of you to consider greeting in the coming months. We'll invite you to greet people as they come to church on Sunday morning (at present all are wearing face masks and not shaking hands – just greeting the people orally.) If it's difficult for you to stand, you can sit, and you can greet with a family member or friend. Also, if your spouse is not a member, we'd welcome your spouse to greet with you on the Sunday you desire. When Wendy or I call to schedule you for greeting, if you're not available on that Sunday, please consider a Sunday when you'd be willing to greet; we'll schedule you for that Sunday. It is a joy to greet and helpful for the young people to know who you are. We look forward to all of you greeting on a Sunday in the coming year.

### Radio Broadcasts:

It is amazing! We now have sponsors for all the remaining Sundays this year – however, if there is a very special day or occasion that you'd like to sponsor the broadcast this year call Wendy at the church office, as she has some who are willing to move their Sunday.

Now as we look forward to 2021 (and we already have 3 sponsors for next Year), if you have a special birthday, anniversary, or occasion that you'd like to sponsor the broadcast, please call the church and reserve that Sunday. We'd like to have you sponsor on the Sunday you like, but sometimes someone else has booked that Sunday, so call if you have a special day you'd like to broadcast. The cost of the broadcast is \$35 per week.

Let us rejoice and give thanks for all the blessings God has given us, and especially the broadcast during this time of the pandemic.

### Confirmation Classes:

At this moment we plan to begin confirmation studies again on Wednesday, September 16<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 PM – but, this could change as school changes and other factors affect us. But, in looking forward we will invite all the students in 6<sup>th</sup> thru 9<sup>th</sup> grades to join us for confirmation instruction. We'll meet in the Fireside Room so students can socially distance and have access to the large screen TV. As students get ready for confirmation classes I'd like to ask the students to read one of the gospels – either Matthew, Luke, or John (not Mark) – before coming to class in September.

Secondly, we are anticipating the Rite of Confirmation to be celebrated on Sunday, January 10, 2021, for those students in the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grades.
