Pastoral Pondering

The American poet Robert Frost writes:

Two roads diverged in a yellow wood,
 And sorry I could not travel both
 And be one traveler, long I stood
 And looked down one as far as I could
 To where it bent in the undergrowth;
 Then took the other, as just as fair,
 And having perhaps the better claim
 Because it was grassy and wanted wear, . . .
 . . . and I,
 I took the one less traveled by,
 And that has made all the difference.

We are all on a journey – a life journey, a personal journey, a faith journey. Each and every day we make choices that affect us and those around us, affect the people we love and with whom we enjoy spending time, and affect our future. What choices will you make today and how will they impact you, those you love, and those with whom you work?

Almighty God made a choice to create the entire universe (to create us), and He said it was all good and very good. Then as time proceeded, He saw the pain His creation was experiencing. However, He didn't walk away, He sent His son to enter into our lives and walk with us, to experience life as we know it.
